Children deserve to feel safe, nurtured and protected. They need to feel confident to share their concerns and trust that these will be taken seriously. The culture, practices and priorities of Mordialloc Community Centre and our affiliate sporting clubs is critical to achieving this.

Mordialloc Community centre complies with the 11 child safe standards mandated by the Australian Commission for Children and Young People

Standard 1

Establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities and experiences of Aboriginal children and young people are respected and valued

Standard 2

Child safety and wellbeing is embedded in our organisational leadership, governance and culture

Standard 3

Children and young people are empowered about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously

Standard 4

Families and community are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing

Standard 5

Equity is upheld and diverse needs respected in policy and practice

Standard 6

People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice

Standard 7

Processes for complaints and concerns are child-focussed

Standard 8

Staff and Volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training

Standard 9

Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed

Standard 10

Implementation of the Child Safe Standards is reviewed and improved on a regular basis

Policies and procedures document how our organisation is safe for children and young people
